STEP 1

Client Consultation

What to expect:

- Introductory conversation to understand your project goals, style preferences, timeline, and budget range.
- Review of inspiration photos, plans, or ideas.
- Explanation of CNC Cabinets Inc.'s process and next steps.

Client considerations:

- Be prepared to discuss how you use your space and what isn't working currently.
- Early budget clarity helps guide design and material decisions.



STEP 3

Quoting, Selections & Approvals

What to expect:

- Detailed quote based on approved design and selections.
- Final review of materials, finishes, hardware, and accessories.
- Sign-off and deposit required before production begins.

Important to know:

- Changes after approval may affect cost and timeline.
- Long-lead items (finishes, hardware, appliances) can impact scheduling.



STEP 5

Installation

What to expect:

- Professional cabinet installation by experienced installers.
- Adjustments and on-site fine-tuning for proper fit and function.

Client considerations:

- The space should be accessible and ready for installation day.
- Some finishing work may occur after countertops are installed.



STEP 2

Design Development

What to expect:

- Preliminary layouts, cabinet concepts, and finish selections.
- Appliance specifications and rough dimensions are reviewed.
- Discussion of storage solutions, functionality, and workflow.

Important to know:

- Design revisions are normal and expected at this stage.
- Some decisions must be finalized before moving forward.



STEP 4

Production & Coordination

What to expect:

- Cabinets are built locally with precision and care.
- Coordination with contractors, trades, and renovation timelines.
- Final countertop measurements are taken once spaces are ready. (For stone counters)

Important to know:

- Stone countertops are templated after cabinets are installed, which can create a natural pause between cabinet install and final countertop install.



STEP 6

Final Touches & Project Completion

What to expect:

- Installation of remaining components (hardware, fillers, panels if applicable).
- Final walkthrough and care instructions.
- Payment of final invoice.
- If applicable, registration of products for warranty coverage.
